In compliance with Section 161.670, RSMo, Rolla Public Schools allows students to access virtual learning opportunities when it is in the best educational interest of the student. For students K-6, RPS does not have a preferred provider; as such, parents/guardians may choose from any of the approved providers listed on the MOCAP website. Due to graduation requirements, the RPS preferred provider for students grade 7-12 is Edgenuity®. Students wishing to take advantage of virtual learning opportunities will do so through Edgenuity and may enroll at their home building. Please note the following parameters:

- 1) The student must be enrolled in Rolla Public Schools as a full-time student. Additionally, the student must have been enrolled in a public school as a full-time student the semester prior to accessing virtual coursework. Students must meet and maintain all pertinent residency requirements of the district.
- 2) Upon determining that virtual learning may be a viable option for a student, parents must contact the school principal or designee to pursue possible enrollment. A team consisting of administrators and counselors will determine student eligibility for MOCAP. Applications for MOCAP must be completed and turned in to the school principal or counselor.
- 3) Acceptance into the virtual program for students with an IEP or 504 will depend on the decision of the IEP or 504 team, as they determine the best educational placement for the individual student.
- 4) Student performance will be reviewed each semester, and any D's or F's may result in the student being removed from the virtual learning program. If a student is removed due to lack of progress during the semester, it may result in loss of credit (if a suitable seated class is not available).
- 5) Students must have access to their own technology resources to participate in a virtual course.
- 6) Students may enroll and withdraw from courses in accordance with district policy and enrollment timelines outlined in the Virtual Learning Handbook.
